Two of our ladies are now enrolled in an 18 month financial responsibility course. They will receive rental assistance and they are enrolled in the savings match program, this will help them succeed as they move into independent living.

PARENTING CLASSES AT TRAVAIL

Proverbs 22:6 - Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

The Bible tells us to train our children so that in their future, when they are adults, they will reap the benefits of our training; and have a solid foundation. For a lot of us, probably most of us, at some time or another, it is hard to know exactly how to carry out our jobs as "Parents."


